

BELLS BOARD MEETING JANUARY 11, 2016

Aldermen present: Bob Pigue, Scotty Runions, Dabney Long and Eric Jordan. Mayor Joe M. Williams, presided. Alicia Pigue, Recorder. Alderman John Pigue, absent.

Others present: Justin Harden, Chief Jenkins, Chief Jernigan and Junior Jordan.

Mayor Williams called the meeting to order and gave invocation.

Alderman Scotty Runions moved to accept the minutes of the previous meeting as written. Alderman Eric Jordan seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.

Mayor Williams discussed an estimate to remodel the City's storage building into a community center. He also discussed the increase in sales tax.

Chief Jenkins presented Justin Harden as candidate for the certified part-time police officer position beginning at \$14.01 per hour with a 180 day probationary period. Alderman Bob Pigue moved to hire Mr. Hardin as presented by Chief Jenkins. Alderman Eric Jordan seconded the motion. All aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.

Mayor Williams discussed purchasing two pieces of playground equipment for the Bells City Park at a cost of \$9,999 purchased on the National Purchasing Alliance. Alderman Eric Jordan moved to purchase the equipment as discussed. Alderman Dabney Long seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.

Mayor Williams presented Ordinance No 011116 **"AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL THE EXISTING SEWER USE ORDINANCE AND ADOPT WASTEWATER REGULATIONS."** For its second and final reading. Alderman Eric Jordan moved to adopt the Ordinance as presented and further moved Mayor Williams to execute any and all necessary documents. Alderman Scotty Runions seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.

Alderman Eric Jordan moved to adopt Resolution No 01112016 to apply for the 2016 CDBG grant. Alderman Scotty Runions seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.

Being no further business Alderman Eric Jordan moved the meeting adjourn. Alderman Scotty Runions seconded the motion. Motion carried.
