

JANUARY 14, 2019
BELLS BOARD MEETING

Aldermen present: Bob Pigue, Scotty Runions, Dabney Long and Eric Jordan. Mayor Joe M. Williams, presided. Alicia Pigue, Recorder.

Others present: Chief Jernigan, Chief Jenkins, Brett Lewis and Junior Jordan.

Mayor Williams called the meeting to order and Alderman Dabney Long gave invocation.

Crockett County Middle School Baseball Coach Brett Lewis addressed the board asking permission to use the Bells Baseball Fields behind the Bells City School for practices and a few games. The Board advised Mr. Lewis to coordinate schedules with the West Tennessee Youth Baseball Association.

Mayor Williams presented the minutes of the November board meeting. Alderman Scotty Runions moved to accept the minutes as written. Alderman Bob Pigue seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.

Mayor Williams presented the minutes of the Special Called meeting in December. Alderman Eric Jordan moved to accept the minutes as written. Alderman Scotty Runions seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.

Mayor Williams presented the financials through December 2018.

Mayor Williams presented Resolution No 01142019 authorizing Mayor Williams to execute and submit an application with appropriate assurances to the State of Tennessee, Department of Economic and Community Development, Office of Program Management, requesting Fiscal Year 2019 Community Development Block Grant funds in the amount not to exceed \$500,000, plus any eligible Three Star bonus allowance for a Sewer System Improvements Project. It further states that the City be held responsible for the local cash/match to be provided in full by the sewer fund account. Alderman Scotty Runions moved to adopt the Resolution as presented. Alderman Dabney Long seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.

Mayor Williams presented two Resolutions, one to select Community Development Partners, LLC for Administrative Services and one to select A2H, Inc for Engineering Services for the 2019 CDBG Sewer Grant based on the Evaluation Worksheets discussed. Alderman Eric Jordan moved to adopt both Resolutions as presented. Alderman Bob Pigue seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.

Mayor Williams discussed a recent bi-annual property survey conducted by Public Entity Partners recommended security cameras be installed in all City owned areas to help in the prevention of crime related behavior.

Being no further business alderman Eric Jordan moved the meeting adjourn. Alderman Dabney Long seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.
