

BELLS BOARD MEETING  
MARCH 13, 2017

Aldermen present: Bob Pigue, John Pigue and Dabney Long. Aldermen Eric Jordan and Scotty Runions, absent. Mayor Joe M. Williams, presided. Alicia Pigue, Recorder.

Others present: Udell Pledge, Wesley Hart, Alma Sherrod, Katie Searcy Taylor, Junior Jordan, Chief Jenkins, Kevin Ligon and Drew Runions.

Mayor Williams called the meeting to order and Alderman Bob Pigue gave invocation.

Alderman Bob Pigue moved to accept the minutes of the previous meeting as written. Alderman Dabney Long seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.

Wesley Hart with Crockett County Youth Baseball Association addressed the Board about funds that were used to keep the fields up and about the need for someone to coordinate when and who uses the fields to hold teams and citizens responsible for any damage done to the fields while in their use. Alderman Bob Pigue moved to appoint Wesley Hart as the City of Bells Baseball Field coordinator giving Mr. Hart control over and making him responsible for duties related to scheduling and keeping the fields neat. Alderman John Pigue seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.

Mayor Williams presented Ordinance No 03132017 **“AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A COMPLIANCE MANUAL REGARDING TITLE VI OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964”** for its second and final reading. Alderman John Pigue moved to adopt the ordinance as presented and same be made apart of the minutes of this meeting in its entirety. Alderman Dabney Long seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.

Mayor Williams presented a list of 2015 delinquent taxes to be turned over to the City Attorney for collection. Alderman Dabney Long moved to turn over the taxes that remain unpaid by April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017. Alderman John Pigue seconded the motion. All Alderman voted, Aye. Motion carried.

Mayor Williams presented the February Financial information along with the February sales tax numbers.

Wesley Hart addressed the Board concerning a School Zone sign and the driveway to the Bells Elementary School.

Alderman Bob Pigue expressed his gratitude to the Bells Police Department for solving the robbery committed at the Bells Hardware Company.

City Superintendent Junior Jordan requested that the Board start his next new hire employee in the Utility Department at \$10.50 per hour for the first six months of employment and \$11.00 per hour after and eventually after five years meeting the

same salary as the workers already employed. Alderman Dabney Long moved to start new employees in the Utility Department as requested by Mr. Jordan. Alderman Bob Pigue seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.

Being no further business Alderman John Pigue moved the meeting adjourn. Alderman Bob Pigue seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted, Aye. Motion carried.
